### **1. Apologies for absence**

### **2. Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

### **3. To agree the minutes from the Green Charity meeting held on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2025**

Cllr McClenaghan proposed that the minutes of the last meeting be signed. This was seconded by Cllr Hargreaves and all agreed. The minutes were duly signed by the Chair.

### **4. Matters Arising from the last meeting**

- Flagship parking area update  
Cllr Hargreaves has spoken to Flagship representatives, and they will be taking the request to a higher level. Hopefully this and a few other issues can be progressed.
- The Green no parking signage  
There are still a number of people parking on the Green, and this is not authorised. The Clerk has sought advice from the Open Spaces Society on the matter. They encourage signage that informs people that they must not park on the Green. Cllr McClenaghan proposed that further enquiries should be made to putting up signage. All agreed with this. Cllr McClenaghan suggested that initially views should be sought from parishioners via Facebook and any feedback gained should be considered.
- To receive an update on the maintenance of the pond  
Mr Romanovsky was asked if he would like to take a lead on the pond maintenance, which he is willing to do. Cllr McClenaghan noted that a grant to fund the improvement of the pond was applied for. Unfortunately the pond was not eligible due to its size.
